Reasons for late testing:

Reasons for which late testing (using an alternate form of the exam) will and will not be allowed are listed below. Only those students affected by the conflict may test late; all other students must test on the regularly scheduled date. Some circumstances are generally beyond the control of school officials and students. In such cases, there will be no additional fee for using an alternate form of the exam.

Reasons for late testing:

- Conflict with International Baccalaureate (IB) exam
- Religious holiday/observance
- Three or more AP Exams on same date
- Two AP Exams on same date and time
